

Ramsar Convention: It is an intergovernmental treaty, adopted on 2nd February 1971, in the Iranian city of Ramsar, on the southern shore of the Caspian sea


In India, it came into force on 1st February 1982, under which wetlands of international importance are declared as Ramsar sites.

The theme of World Wetland Day, 2024 is <u>'Wetlands and Human Wellbeing'</u> which underscores the critical role wetlands play in enhancing our lives.

- Bengaluru gears up to participate in world's biggest annual bird counting exercise. the event is being coordinated in India by Bengaluru-based Bird Count India, an umbrella group comprising birding, nature and conservation organisations across India.

The event titled "Nanoo Rani Chennamma" (I too am Rani Chennamma) will be held in Kittur in Belagavi district on February----- Kittur Declaration asks women to fight for land and people, women's dignity, and livelihood
- Chennamma was born on 23° October 1778 in Kakati, a small village in the Belagavi district of Karnataka.

 She is among the first rulers of India who fought against the British
- MODERATO (Manage- ment of Origin-Destina- tion-Related Adaptation for Traffic Optimisation) technology.-
- MODERATO is the nucleus of the integrated traffic control systems, and is the core of the
 universal traffic management systems (UTMS). This system is making a great contribution
 to the traffic safety and smoothness by using its advanced signal control technology. Trial
 run begins in Bengaluru of traffic control system aided by Japanese MODERATO technology
- The 'Indira Gandhi Award for Best Debut Film of a Di-rector' and the 'Nargis Dutt Award for Best Feature Film on National Integra-tion', which are part of the National Film Awards, have been renamed on the re-commendation of the Committee for Rationalisation of Film Awards.
- Scientists made a surprising discovery in the foothills of the Western Ghats in India — a mushroom growing out of the side of the frog.

- ISRO to launch INSAT-3DS on Feb WIII improve Weather forecasts. The 'INSAT-3DS' is a
 continuation to the Third Generation Meteorological Satellite series from the
 geostationary orbit. Presently, meteorologists make extensive use of data generated by
 satellites like the INSAT-3D and INSAT-3DR (launched in September, 2016, still operational).
- The Australian government is hoping to pass a Bill that will institute a "right to disconnect,"
 The "Right to Disconnect" is a proposed human right where a person will have a right to
 disconnect from his/her work or one can say no to engagement in work-related
 communications i.e. emails, calls, and messages during non-working hours.







- The GROW report and portal was launched by a Member of NITI Aayog: The "Greening and Restoration of Wasteland with Agroforestry (GROW)- Suitability Mapping" portal allows universal access to state and district-level data.
- The GROW initiative aligns with national commitments, aiming to restore 26 million hectares of degraded land by 2030 and create an additional carbon sink of 2.5 to 3 billion tonnes of carbon dioxide equivalent.

- Supreme Court calls electoral bonds 'quid pro quo'(a favour or advantage granted in return for something.), asks SBI to stop issuing them <u>Supreme Court</u> (SC) has referred petitions challenging the <u>2018 Electoral Bonds Scheme</u> to a <u>five-judge</u> Constitution Bench.

The electoral bonds system was introduced in 2017 by way of a Finance bill and it was implemented in 2018, State Bank of India (SBI) issues the bonds in denominations of Rs 1,000, Rs 10,000, Rs 1 lakh, Rs 10 lakh, and Rs 1 crore. Payable to the bearer on demand and interest-free.

- The world's second-largest road network is found in India, India possesses the world's second-largest road network, after the United States, The Network National Highway is 1,44,000 km long overall
- India approves 100% foreign direct investment (FDI) in space sector
- India's five-fold plan (Panchamrit) at COP26:
 - 1. Non-fossil energy capacity to reach 500 GW by 2030;
 - 2. To meet 50% of its energy requirements with renewable energy by 2030;
 - 3. To reduce its total projected carbon emissions by a billion tonnes by 2030;
 - 4. To reduce the carbon intensity of its economy to less than 45% and
 - 5. To achieve net zero by 2070.
- Blue or Baal Aadhaar is issued for children under five, it contains the 12-digit unique identification number but not the biometric data,
- A Blue or Baal Aadhaar card is an identification document issued to children under five. Introduced in 2018, the Aadhaar card for kids does not record any biometric information. It is called blue Aadhaar because of its blue colour, instead of the white rectangular card issued to adults.



- Kerala government announced the India's first Graphene Innovation Centre: Graphene is an incredibly thin sheet of carbon arranged in a honeycomb pattern.
- The Tamil Nadu government banned the sale and production of cotton candy in the state after it was found that the chemical Rhodamine-B was being used for making it, which is harmful for health.
- DURGA-2 (Directionally Unrestricted Ray Gun Array), the Indian laser weapon holds the
 promise of altering the dynamics of modern warfare, Directed energy weapons like
 DURGA-2 operate by focusing energy, whether laser, microwave, or particle beams, to
 disable or destroy targets.
- MP govt has decided to observe 'bag less school' once in a week for school students from session 2024-25 in the state
- <u>8th Asia Economic Dialogue</u> to be held in Pune. he annual geo-economics conference, organised jointly by the MEA and Pune International Centre, will be held from February 29 to March 2, It focused on the theme, 'Geo-economic Challenges in an Era of Flux'.







- The Karnataka State Cabinet have approved a proposal to recommend to the Centre to declare <u>six wildlife sanctuaries</u> and areas around another sanctuary in Karnataka as <u>ecologically sensitive zones</u>. - US' Odysseus becomes first-ever private spacecraft to land on Moon, The spacecraft,
 Odysseus, touched down near the South Pole of the Moon on Thursday night. This is also the first successful lunar landing by a US spacecraft since the Apollo 17 mission in 1972.
- Mahamastakabhisheka Mahotsava of Bhagavan Shri Bahubali Swami, the first Mokshagami and son of the <u>first Theerthankara of Jainism</u>, began with rituals at Venur in Belthangady taluk of Dakshina Kannada district on Thursday. This is the third edition of Mahamastakabhisheka, after the 2000 and 2012 events.
- NaViGate Bharat Portal: National Video Gateway of Bharat, It has developed by developed by the New Media Wing of the Ministry of IB. It empowers citizens by providing a single platform with an interactive user interface to search, stream, share, and download videos related to various Government schemes, initiatives, and campaigns, with filter-based advanced search option
- India's First Gati Shakti Research Chair established at IIM Shillong Union Minister
- PM inaugurates <u>Sudarshan Setu</u>, India's longest cablestayed bridge, in Dwarka
- The 2.32-km-long bridge connects Okha mainland and Beyt Dwarka island. It was built at a cost of around ₹980 crore and features a footpath adorned with verses from the Bhagavad Gita and images of Lord Krishna on both sides.


