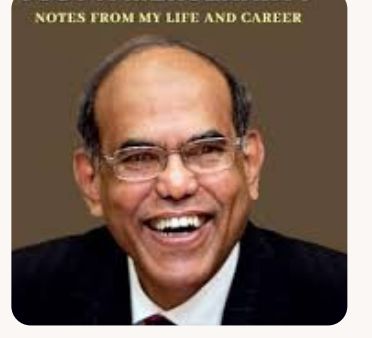
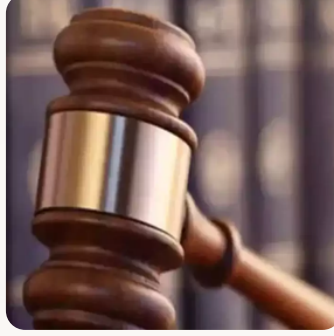

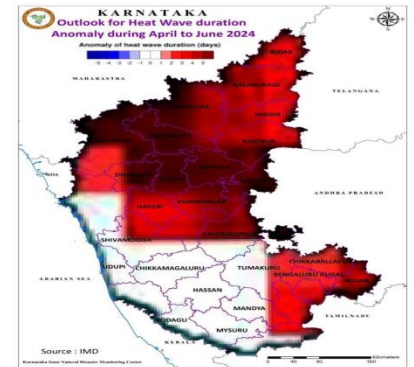
Indian Air Force (IAF) has begun its 10-day Gagan Shakti war drill to test its capabilities.

All about GI Tag :

- The GI tag concept is borrowed from Section 22(1) of the TRIPS Agreement of the WTO.
- GI tags have been issued in India since 2003 under the Geographical Indications (Registration and Protection of Goods) Act-1999.
- The Department of industry promotion and internal trade under the Union Ministry of Commerce and Industry is the nodal agency for issuing GI tags in India.
- GI tag once issued is valid for 10 years and can be re-applied for any amount of time after expiry.
- GI tags are given only to goods of local importance, not to services.
- Germany has the highest number of GI tags in the world (around 15000+).
- Darjeeling tea was the first commodity to be GI tagged in India (2004).
- The first foreign product to receive GI tag in India is Peruvian Fisco (a wine).
- Uttar Pradesh state received highest GI tags in India
- recent GI tag Karnataka received is "Kagji Lemon" of Indi Taluk, Vijayapura district
- Uttarakhand becomes first state to get 18 Geographical Indication tags in a single day
- India aims to construct its first commercial crude oil strategic storage to bolster reserves as a precaution against potential supply interruptions. Indian Strategic Petroleum Reserves Limited (ISPRL) has invited bids for building 2.5 million tonnes of underground storage at Padur in Karnataka.

- Indian Army gets portable Igla-S Air defence system from Russia. The Igla-S system is being acquired to enhance the Indian Army's Very Short Range Air Defence (VSHORAD) capabilities. The Igla-S is a hand-held defence system that can be operated by an individual.

- Right Against climate change is a Fundamental Right - Article 21 and Article 14 by Supreme court
- The World Bank estimates India's GDP growth for FY24 at 7.5%, indicating a robust economic performance. This projection reflects optimism about India's economic activity and potential for growth in the coming fiscal year.
- Mirabai Chanu, known for her Tokyo Olympics silver medal, is the only Indian weightlifter to qualify for the Paris Olympics. She achieved this feat after finishing 11th overall in the IWF World Cup in Thailand, meeting the qualification criteria despite returning from a six-month injury.
- The Defence Research and Development Organisation (DRDO) is establishing a test centre for weapon systems in Junput village, West Bengal. This initiative aims to alleviate the testing workload at Odisha's Chandipur Integrated Test Range (ITR) and enhance operational capabilities.
- Bilquis Mir, a canoeist from Jammu and Kashmir, is poised to make history as the first Indian woman to serve as a jury member at the Paris Olympics. Her journey reflects her determination and passion for the sport, breaking barriers and contributing significantly to Indian sports.
- The Tri-Service conference 'Parivartan Chintan' will be held in New Delhi. This conference will be the first-ever gathering of heads of all tri-services institutions, chaired by Chief of Defence Staff (CDS), General Anil Chauhan
- Unemployment rates across Indian States in 2022-23
 - ✓ At almost 10%, Goa's unemployment rate —more than three times the national average (3.17%) — is the highest.
 - ✓ Interestingly, 4 of the top 5 States — Goa, Kerala, Haryana and Punjab — are comparatively richer states.
 - ✓ The rich States of western India — Maharashtra and Gujarat — experience unemployment rates far less than the national average.
 - ✓ All northern States — Jammu and Kashmir, Punjab, Haryana, Uttarakhand and Himachal Pradesh — have unemployment rates higher than the national average
 - ✓ all southern States have unemployment rates higher than the national average with the exception of Karnataka.

- **Amitabh Bachchan** awarded "Lata Mangeskar Puraskar". PM Modi was its 1st recipient, followed by Asha Bhosle in 2023.

- **Nigeria** launched World's First Universal Meningitis Vaccine: Nigeria introduced "**MenFive**" vaccine, combating all meningitis strains in under-5s, aiming to reduce disease impact in Africa's meningitis belt.

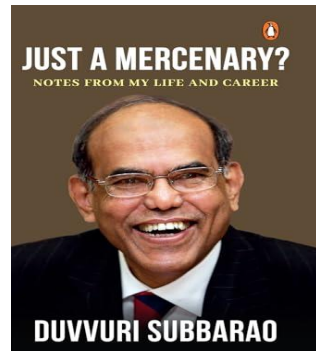
- The World Future Energy Summit 2024 organised in Abu Dhabi. The 16th World Future Energy Summit commenced in Abu Dhabi.

- **Project Akashteer** is an initiative developed by Bharat Electronics Limited under the 'Atmanirbhar Bharat' scheme.

- China has established the **world's first 'nears pace command'**, equipped with powerful hypersonic weapons, as its 5th force.

- **Alliance for Global Good – Gender Equity and Equality:** It was launched at WEF Davos 2024, It is a collective of Governments, Industry and Development organisations.
- **Mission Utkarsh** - Initiative for Anaemia Control among adolescent girls using Ayurveda interventions. The Centre launched an initiative to improve nutrition in adolescent girls (14-18 years) using Ayurveda.
- India ranked third globally in unicorn creation with 67 unicorns, trailing behind the United States with 703 unicorns and China with 340, as per the Hurun Global Unicorn Index. This position reflects India's status in the global startup ecosystem, despite a decline in unicorn creation for the first time since 2017.
- Israel deployed its C-Dome defence system, a naval adaptation of the Iron Dome, for the first time against an aerial threat near Eilat. This incident underscores Israel's proactive stance in utilizing advanced military technologies like the C-Dome to counter potential threats, demonstrating its commitment to enhancing national security measures.
- The Asian Wrestling Championships 2024 were hosted in Bishkek, Kyrgyzstan, where Indian wrestler Udit won the silver medal in the men's 57kg category. Additionally, Abhimanyu and Vicky claimed bronze medals in their respective weight divisions, further showcasing India's success in the tournament held in Kyrgyzstan.
- ISRO achieved the 'zero orbital debris' milestone with its PSLV-C58/XPoSat mission by transforming the last stage into POEM-3 and de-orbiting it to ensure no debris remained in orbit.
- Adani Green Energy is constructing the world's largest renewable energy park in Khavda, Kutch district of Gujarat. Spread over 538 square kilometres, it will have a total capacity of 30 GW, making it a significant renewable energy initiative in India.
- India's second artificial reef installation is near Worli Koliwada, Mumbai. The project involves deploying 210 reef units made from recycled concrete and steel, aiming to boost marine life and create habitats for various marine organisms. The use of Bio-rock technology in this installation is a significant step toward enhancing marine ecosystems and supporting local fishing communities.
- The **CDP-SURAKSHA** initiative by the Indian government is aimed at revolutionizing horticulture subsidies, and streamlining their distribution through digital integration and secure payment mechanisms. This initiative is a significant step towards supporting horticulture farmers and promoting growth in the horticulture sector.
- The author of the memoir "**Just a Mercenary** : Notes from My Life and Career" is Duvvuri Subbarao, the former Governor of the Reserve Bank of India (RBI). - Pragya Misra was appointed as OpenAI's first employee in India, taking on the role of head of government relations. She previously held the position of Director of Public Affairs at Truecaller and assumed her new role during the ongoing 2024 Lok Sabha Elections in India, marking a significant development in OpenAI's presence and operations in the country.
- The Shompen Tribes from Great Nicobar Island participated in voting for the first time. As a Particularly Vulnerable Tribal Group (PVTG), they reside in dense tropical rainforests and belong to the Mongoloid group.
- The Embassy of Israel in India collaborated with a non-profit entity to join the 'Million Miyawaki' project, aimed at planting a million trees in Delhi-NCR as part of Earth Day celebrations.
- India is expanding cooperation on high technologies, including 6G, with the European Union under the EU-India Trade and Technology Council. The Bharat 6G Alliance, initiated by the Department of Telecommunications, signifies India's commitment to advancing 6G technology through collaboration with industry, academia, and research institutions.

Unsung Heroes of Freedom Struggle



Mundargi Bhima Rao was a hero of the 1858 uprisings in the Dharwad district of Karnataka.

Rao, a commoner, fought side by side with the landlords and shook the British army to its very core.

Rao served the British at Mundargi as a land revenue officer.

In 1854, he was finally dismissed from his position as a result of his protests against the British exploitation of the peasantry. He led the anti-tax propaganda in Dharwad and urged people to join the anti-British movement. In 1857 itself, he gathered 300-400 people and planned a revolt at Hammigi. However, he had to hold the plan as the information leaked and the District Collector got to know about their plan. He was a friend of Nana Saheb and the latter urged him to revolt in his letters.
