## Karnataka

- It empowers the enforcement directorate to seize in India assets equivalent to foreign exchange, foreign security or any immovable property held outside India in violation of FEMA.

- women heads of households will be given a monthly allowance of Rs 2,000

- To provide free electricity to households in Karnataka
- Consumption of less than 200 units/month, no outstanding bills

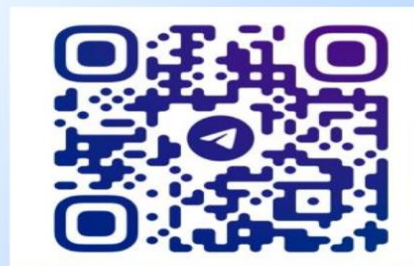

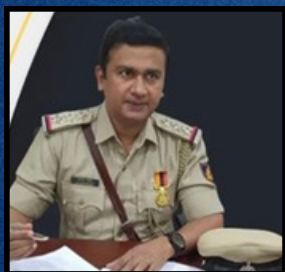
