Karnataka

- **Mangalooru Samachara**: the first newspaper published in Kannada. It was produced by a German, Rev. **Hermann Friedrich** of the Basel Mission beginning in 1843
- Thermal done was used in Karnataka to track the elephant movements, for the first time in the country it was used to manage man animal conflict.
- Karnataka's lion-tailed macaque population highest in world- according to a study by the Karnataka Forest Department and Coimbatore-based Salim Ali Centre for Ornithology and Natural History (SACON)
- The study gave a big boost to conservation efforts as it found that the population of LTMs in the Sharavathi Valley Lion-Tailed Macaque Sanctuary (SVLTMS) spread across Shivamogga and Uttara Kannada districts.
- SAAF- (The South Asian Football Federation Championship, commonly known as SAFF Cup) Championship- The event was held at the **SreeKanteerava Stadium in Bangalore, India**, India defeated Kuwait in the final to lift the SAFF Championship 2023 trophy. Sunil Chhetri led from the front with 6 goals.
- The highest producer of dragon fruit is Bellary district in Karnataka, All the States in India except cold areas are suitable for dragon fruit plants Gujarat has given dragon fruit the Sanskrit name 'Kamalam' The world's largest producer and exporter of dragon fruit is Vietnam
- Karnataka govt constitutes Commission headed by **Justice Bhaktavatsala** to study political representation of backward classes
- Elena Geo Systems, a Bengaluru-based firm, has unveiled the country's first hand-held navigation device based on the Indian Regional Navigation Satellite System (NavIC)
- **Karnataka state budget**- Karnataka Chief Minister Siddaramaiah presented his 14th State Budget on July 7.
- He presented a Budget with a total outlay of ₹3,27,747 cores
- Which city is set to launch Kaveri 2.0 Web based property registration application- Bangalore

- Karnataka is followed by Tamil Nadu (TN) in 2nd position and Telangana in 3rd position. as per the India Justice report- published by Tata Institute of Social Sciences
- Punyakoti Government Goshala, Yemmedoddi- This was the first Government Goshala in the state of Karnataka by Department of Animal Husbandry and Veterinary Services
- The indigenous breeds of Karnataka- Hallikar, amrutmal , malnad gidda
- Pashu Sanjeevini (Mobile Animal Surgery Vehicle): Under the Livestock Health and Disease Control Programme, 290 well-equipped mobile veterinary vehicles have been provided to provide emergency veterinary services at the doorsteps of farmers.
- Amruta Siri Scheme: A program of distribution of surplus female calves/heifers/cows/buffaloes available in all livestock areas of the department under "Amrita Siri" scheme to farmers/devasi/widows/war widows/cremation workers in districts where breeds are available at 25% of book price. Thereby farmers are encouraged to breed more indigenous breeds of cows.

- NITI Ayog releases the 2022- export preparedness index, Tamil Nadu tops the rank followed by Maharashtra and 3rd Karnataka

Child Welfare and Protection Committee (CW&PC) at village level will identify the children who are eligible for support likely to be in difficult circumstances, orphans, street children etc.
- J&K launches India's first chatbot for people in distress- India's first TeleMANAS chatbot which will start an instant conversation with people in distress
- Integrated ombudsman scheme: it was launched integrated ombudsman scheme?
- It was launched by Prime Minister Narendra Modi on 12 November, 2021. Science and technology

- **Space History of India:**
Aryabhata. The Aryabhata spacecraft, named after the famous Indian astronomer, was India's first satellite; it was completely designed and fabricated in India and launched by a Soviet Kosmos-3M rocket from Kapustin Yar on April 19, 1975
- **Rohini, the first satellite to be placed in orbit by an Indian-made launch vehicle (the Satellite Launch Vehicle 3), was launched on July 18, 1980.**
- Chandrayan-3: The total Chandrayaan 3 Cost is Rs 615 crores which is lower than the Chandrayaan 2 cost
- Chandrayaan-3 is India's third lunar mission and second attempt at achieving a soft landing on the moon's surface.

The **Lander (Vikram) and rover payloads(Pragyan) of Chandrayaan-3 remain the same as the Chandrayaan-2 mission.**

The **LVM3 M4 launcher** has been successfully utilized to launch Chandrayaan-3

Chandrayaan-3's journey is estimated to take approximately 42 days, with a landing scheduled for August 23, 2023 at the lunar dawn.

It will be the first prototype hydrogen train

- A greenfield airport is an aviation facility with greenfield project characteristics. The designation reflects certain environmental qualities (using previously undeveloped or empty greenfield land, for example) and commissioning, planning and construction processes that are generally carried out from scratch and Gujarat first Green filed Airport- The Hirasar Greenfield Airport, located at around 30 km from Rajkot and Karnataka first green filed airport- Hubli airport

The World Meteorological Organization and the United Nations Environment Programme established the IPCC in 1988, **Headquarters: Geneva, Switzerland**
- **Abbreviation: IPCC**

- **Operation Trinetra II'** has been launched by the security forces to neutralise hiding terrorists in Jammu and Kashmir's Poonch
- **Inner line permit:** is an official travel document issued by the Government of India to allow inward travel of an Indian citizen into a protected area for a limited period.
- **AFSPA -1958:** The Indian States that are under AFSPA Act are Jammu and Kashmir, Nagaland, Assam, and Arunachal Pradesh.

- The 17th Indian Cooperative Congress is being organized on 1-2 July, 2023, The All India Cooperative Congress, held at Patna in 1956, prosperity through cooperation for vibrant India.

- Global Multidimensional Poverty Index (MPI) 2023 has been released by the United Nations Development Programme (UNDP) and the Oxford Poverty and Human Development Initiative (OPHI): Its 3 indicators are Health, Education and standard of living

- The Third Culture Working Group meeting under India's **G20 Presidency concluded today** in Hampi Karnataka. hence this topics is significant important for the upcoming KPSC Exams
- It is the home of the former capital of the famous Vijayanagara Empire and it's **capital Hampi**, which is now one of the **UNESCO World Heritage Sites**.
- The Vijayanagara empire was based in the Deccan, in peninsular and southern India, from 1336 onwards. **It was founded by Harihara, also known as Hakka, and his brother Bukka Raya**. It is named after its capital city (now ruined) of Vijayanagara, in modern Karnataka, India. It lasted from about 1336 to perhaps about 1660, though throughout its last century it

was in a slow decline due to a massive and catastrophic defeat at the hands of an alliance of the sultanates, and the capital was taken and brutally razed and looted.

- **Chandikesvara Temple**: Lord Vishnu temple. **Ganagitti Temple** – a Jain temple. **Hemakuta group of Temples** – A cluster of ancient shrines, many of them devoted to Lord Shiva.
- Which river flows in Hampi: **Tungabhadra- UPSC**
- **TungaBhadra Dam (TB Dam)** is a multipurpose dam built across TungaBhadra River in Hosapete, Ballari district. TB Dam has several attractions for visitors

- The first national flag in India is said to have been hoisted on August 7, 1906, in the **Parsee Bagan Square (Green Park)**
- The historic dhwaja satyagraha was held in the small village of Shivapura in Maddur taluk of Mandya district in 1938. Inspired by a similar event in Haripur, Gujarat that same year — presided over by Subhas Chandra Bose — the village also planned to hoist the tricolour.
- Madam Bhikaiji Cama became the first person to hoist the Indian flag in foreign land on 22 August 1907. While unfurling the flag at the International Socialist Conference in Stuttgart, Germany,
- **India has climbed seven places on Henley Passport Index 2023 to 80th rank from 87 last year** though the number of countries allowed visa-free access to Indian passport holders remain unchanged. Singapore has topped the passport rankings with visa-free access to 192 global destinations
- **Katchatheevu**, in the Palk Strait, is a tiny island, and is located about 14 nautical miles from Rameswaram in India. The proximity of the isle to both countries, India and Sri Lanka, has been the cause of its being a bone of contention between the two nations for decades now
- **The World Para Athletics Championships**, known as the IPC Athletics World Championships prior to 2017, are a biennial Paralympic athletics event organized by World Para Athletics, a subcommittee of the International Paralympics' Committee — place it was held- France Paris
- **The 2023 Wimbledon Championships was a Grand Slam tennis tournament that took place at the All England Lawn Tennis and Croquet Club in Wimbledon, London, United Kingdom, Carlos Alcaraz defeated the four-time defending champion Novak Djokovic in the final**
- **India and other members of the Shanghai Cooperation Organisation (SCO) have extended their support to China-led initiative "Solidarity-2023"- in a bid to organise a joint border operation in 2023.**
- **Iran, one of India's neighbours in its extended neighbourhood, has formally become a full member of Shanghai Cooperation Organization (SCO). hosting the next Shanghai Cooperation Summit 2023 virtually**

- Brazil will host the G20 in 2024, followed by South Africa in 2025.

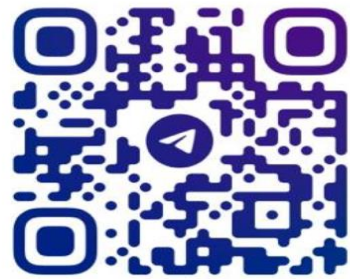
