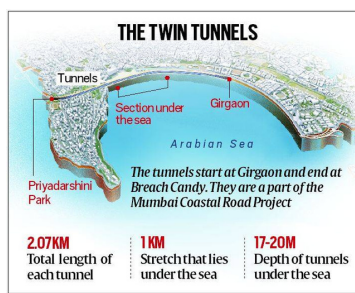

Toppers Talk

She had failed 5 attempts in the UPSC, but her never-say-die attitude allowed her to crack KAS.

Congratulations on your achievement in the state public service commission commonly called KAS and getting into commercial tax division.

Please introduce yourself?

I am Mehrunnissa Begum, a resident of Shahabad in the Kalburgi District. I graduated in agriculture and then took the ICAR-JRF, passing with an All India ranking of 32. I then enrolled in the National Dairy Research Institute in Karnal and completed a master's degree in agricultural extension education. Since then, I have been studying for this exam.

How many times did you try?

This was my second effort; in my first, I got to the interview stage but didn't make the cut for the final list, and in my second, I passed every level.

Who has been the inspiration to appear for the KAS?

I'm from the most backward part of Karnataka, where completing degree is still a pipe dream and raising girls from the Muslim community is still a significant difficulty. I've always wanted to do something to improve society and promote girls' education.

Moreover, my husband constantly encouraged me to continue my preparation. After a serious accident in which both of my legs were broken, he managed to keep my spirits up and provide me with valuable guidance.

How did your parents, family and friends contribute to your success?

My parents and family had entire faith in me when I was sent out of state to pursue my master's, and they always had faith in my accomplishment.

Friends indeed backbone in your preparation.

What was your approach to clear KAS?

I could take short notes on each subject, talk about them with my peers, and revise them several times. I chose to construct my own test series and have the peer group evaluate it. Each day was fascinating and fresh, so studying didn't get too monotonous.

For prelims, I used to solve previous year question paper and relay more on Government sources like, PIB, Yojana, Kurukshetra, etc.

Had you not been selected in the Civil Services Examination, what would have been your reaction? Which other service/career would you have gone in/opted for?

I had always had a decent chance of getting a job in my academic field. I could have been an agriculture scientist or assistant professor, but I always wanted to get in Administration. I could have reapplied and qualified.

How do you visualize your success?

It provided some relief, but it also added a new responsibility to my plate. Whenever I visit my hometown, parents ask me to help them with their daughters, and schools help me inspire aspirants, which I think makes me feel good and proud.

What were your strong points which enabled you to achieve success in the state Civil Services Examination?

Persistence, hard work and dedication

What is your advice to the aspirants?

In a recent incident in Maharashtra, a young aspirant died by suicide as a result of their repeated failures in the UPSC for three years. Never expect immediate results because great responsibility comes with a lot of hard work that builds character. I failed the UPSC miserably, but I kept practicing no matter what.

Believe yourself, stay motivated and be strong and accept the defeat before trying

1. Galapagos Islands

2. Central Asian Flyway

- Central Asian Flyway (CAF) covers a large area of Eurasia between the Arctic and Indian Oceans.
- One of the nine most important flyways for migratory birds around the world
- Including India, there are 30 countries under the Central Asian Flyway.

- Odisha is the largest mass nesting site for Oliver Ridleys in the world.



6. Milkweed butterflies

- Milkweed Butterflies are a diverse group of butterflies belonging to the brush-footed butterfly family.
- They feed mainly on milkweed plants and sometimes on nightshade.
- These butterflies fly slowly, and some migrate great distances.

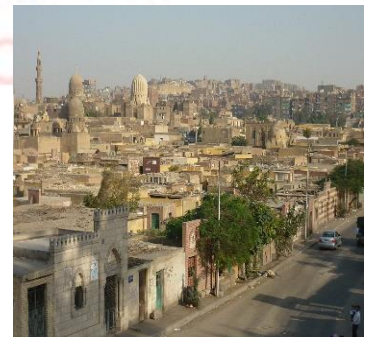

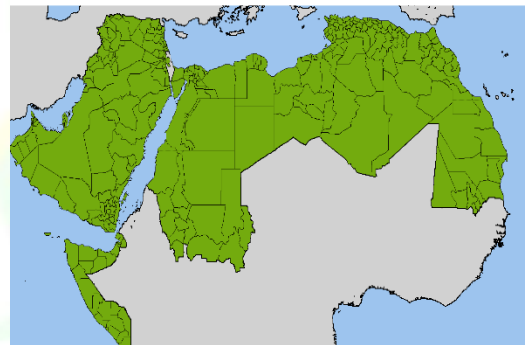

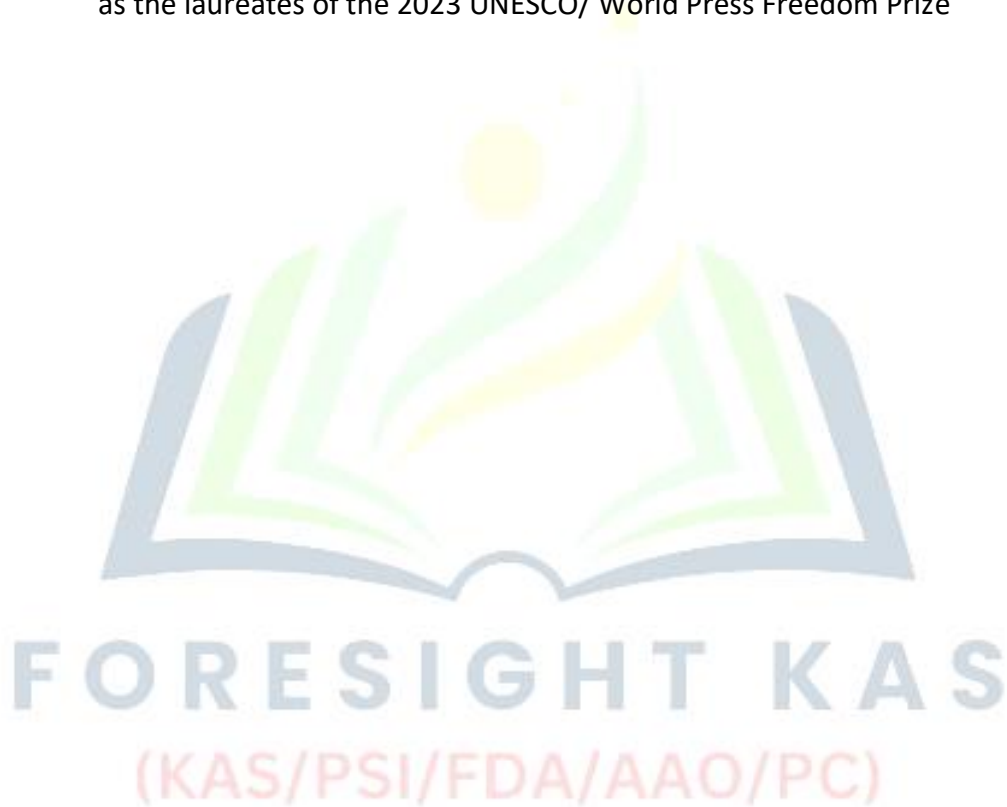
