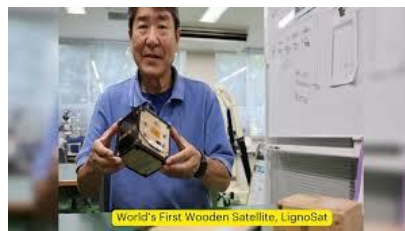
- The Indian Space Research Organisation (ISRO) launched its pioneering analog space mission from **Leh, Ladakh**. This strategic choice leverages Ladakh's unique Mars-like terrain and conditions to simulate an interplanetary habitat. The mission, led by the **Human Space Flight Centre**, collaborates with various institutions, including AAKA Space Studio, the University of Ladakh, IIT Bombay, and the Ladakh Autonomous Hill Development Council
- India has made significant progress in innovation, jumping to the **39th position in the Global Innovation Index (GII) of 2024**, as reported by the World Intellectual Property Organization (WIPO).
- The **BioE3 Policy**, launched as part of India's commitment to innovation in the agriculture sector, focuses on leveraging biotechnology to boost the economy, - (**Biotechnology for Economy, Environment and Employment**)
- The 'Namo Drone Didi' scheme is designed to **empower Women Self Help Groups (SHGs) by equipping them with drones for agricultural use**. Part of the Deendayal Antyodaya Yojana-National Rural Livelihoods Mission (**DAY-NRLM**), this initiative provides 80% financial assistance and training for SHGs, enabling women to offer drone-based services for spraying fertilizers and pesticides, which improves crop yield and efficiency.

Department of Agriculture & Farmers Welfare (DoA&FW) launched the Namo Drone Didi to empower 14,500 Women Self-Help Groups (SHGs) under the Deendayal Antyodaya Yojana-National Rural Livelihood Mission (DAY-NRLM). Central financial assistance covers 80% of drone cost, up to Rs. 8 lakhs. Additional funding options available through Agriculture Infrastructure Financing Facility (AIF). Mandatory 15-day training to be provided to one of the members of women SHGs as a drone pilot

- India's **72nd ranking** in the **AI Preparedness Index 2023** reflects its progress in embracing artificial intelligence.- released by The International Monetary Fund (IMF)
- The First Asian Buddhist Summit aims to strengthen Asian unity and explore the role of Buddha Dhamma in achieving this goal. The summit's strategic location in **New Delhi** underscores India's significance as a hub for Buddhist heritage and culture
- India was re-elected as the President** of the International Solar Alliance (ISA) during the Assembly held in New Delhi, with France serving as Co-President for the **2024-2026 term**. This leadership role underscores India's commitment to advancing solar energy for global energy security and climate goals. The ISA Assembly prioritizes energy access, security, and the transition to a carbon-neutral future, with a focus on attracting **\$1 trillion in solar investments by 2030**.
- The Indian Olympic Association has taken the first formal step towards hosting the Olympics in India by submitting a 'Letter of Intent' to the International Olympic Committee's Future Host Commission. The proposed year for hosting the **Games is 2036**, which is expected to bring significant economic growth, social progress, and empowerment to India's youth.
- LignoSat, the world's first wooden satellite**, represents a groundbreaking collaboration between Japan's Kyoto University and Sumitomo Forestry. Launched via a SpaceX mission to the International Space Station, LignoSat aims to test the resilience of honoki wood, a Japanese magnolia species, in extreme space conditions.
- The United Arab Emirates (UAE) will host a national pavilion at the 29th Conference of the Parties (COP29) in Baku, Azerbaijan, under the theme "Accelerating Climate Action Together"
 - United Arab Emirates (UAE) launched the Global Energy Efficiency Alliance (GEEA) at COP29 in Azerbaijan
 - The 2025 UN Climate Change Conference (UNFCCC COP 30) will convene in **November 2025 in Belém, Brazil**.

- Bengaluru has taken a significant step in promoting awareness about population growth with the launch of **India's first digital population clock**. Inaugurated at the **Institute for Social and Economic Change**, this innovative display provides real-time updates on Karnataka's population every 1 minute 10 seconds and India's population every 2 seconds.
- The Aditya-L1 mission is India's pioneering venture to study the Sun from a unique vantage point about 1.5 million kilometres from Earth. The **Visible Emission Line Coronagraph (VELC)** is the primary payload of this mission, designed to observe the Sun's outer atmosphere or corona.
- The European Space Agency (ESA) spearheads the Proba-3 mission, a pioneering venture in precision formation flying and solar observation- the mission was launched from Sriharikota by ISRO.
- Kodo millet (*Paspalum scrobiculatum*) is a hardy, drought-tolerant crop with high yield potential. It is widely cultivated in India, particularly in Madhya Pradesh. However, it is also associated with mycotoxins, specifically **Cyclopiazonic acid (CPA)**, which can cause Kodo poisoning. – Kodo millet is associated with mycotoxins potentially causing elephant deaths in Bandhavgarh Tiger Reserve
- Bengaluru, Karnataka, has been chosen as the location for the **BIMSTEC Energy Centre**, following the signing of a Host Country Agreement between India and BIMSTEC-
- Article 124** of the Indian Constitution outlines the provisions for the appointment of the Chief Justice of India and other Supreme Court judges
- Gujarat's Dinosaur Fossil Park and Museum, located in Raiyoli village, is being advocated for a **UNESCO Global Geoparks tag**, recognizing its significance as a geological heritage site. The park boasts an impressive collection of dinosaur fossils, one of the largest in the world. Gujarat, along with Madhya Pradesh and Maharashtra, is renowned for its rich dinosaur fossil deposits, including skeletons and eggs, shedding light on

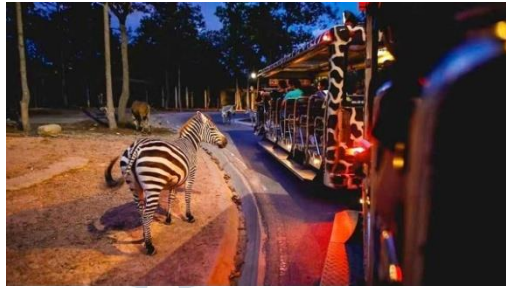

- **Brazil is hosting the G20 Summit in Rio De Janeiro**, emphasizing its leadership within the **G20 Troika, which includes India and South Africa**. The summit's theme, "**Building a Just World and a Sustainable Planet**," focuses on equitable global development and sustainability
- **K. Sanjay Murthy**, a seasoned 1989 batch IAS officer from the Himachal Pradesh cadre, has taken over as India's new **Comptroller and Auditor General**, replacing **Girish Chandra Murmu**.
- India's heaviest communication satellite, **GSAT-N2**, weighs approximately 4,700 kg and is **scheduled to launch on SpaceX's Falcon-9** from **Cape Canaveral**. **GSAT-N2** aims to enhance internet services, particularly in remote areas, with an operational life of 14 years.
- **Coal India Ltd** was honoured with the **prestigious Green World Environment Award 2024** in the **CSR category** for its **Thalassemia Bal Sewa Yojna**. This initiative provides curative treatment through stem cell transplants to over 600 **Thalassemia patients**, demonstrating the company's commitment to social responsibility and community welfare.
- **International Gita Mahotsav 2024**: A Celebration of Culture, Spirituality, and Global Unity , A Grand Cultural Event The International Gita Mahotsav will be celebrated from **November 28 to December 15, 2024**, in **Kurukshetra, Haryana**.
- **Union home minister Amit Shah** on Tuesday launched a new mobile application, the **Civil Registration System (CRS)**, for **birth and death registration**.- Developed by the **Registrar General and Census Commissioner of India**, the app is expected to reduce the time required for these registrations seamlessly

- Karnataka Launches ELEVATE 2024 and Karnataka Acceleration Network (KAN)
 - ELEVATE 2024: Aimed at identifying and supporting high-potential startups across various sectors.

• PM to launch UN **International Year of Cooperatives 2025**

- Prime Minister Narendra Modi will launch the 'United Nations International Year of Cooperatives 2025' at the International Cooperative Alliance's (ICA) global conference to be held in New Delhi.
- First time in the 130 years of history of the ICA General Assembly and Global Cooperative Conference will be hosted in India.

- The Income Tax India PAN Card has a ten-digit alphanumeric number, which is known as the PAN. PANs are given out in the form of a laminated plastic card (commonly known as a PAN card). The final character, i.e. the tenth, is an alphabetic check digit

Govt approves PAN 2.0 cards soon to have QR Codes, project worth ₹1435 crore launched!

(New PAN Cards for taxpayers & businesses will come mainstream.)

- India has secured the **10th position** in the Climate Change Performance Index (CCPI) 2025, published jointly by Germanwatch, New Climate Institute, and Climate Action Network International. This ranking reflects India's efforts to address climate change. **Denmark tops the list, followed closely by the Netherlands and the UK.**

- **Daniel Barenboim, a world-renowned pianist and conductor, and Ali Abu Awwad, a dedicated peace activist,** were jointly awarded the **Indira Gandhi Prize for Peace, Disarmament and Development 2023.**

- **Hornbill Festival, also known as the "Festival of Festivals, Held annually from December 1-10 in Kisama, Nagaland, the festival showcases the music, dance, and crafts of various ethnic communities.**

- **Armenia has joined the International Solar Alliance (ISA) as its 104th full member** as of November 15, 2024. The exchange of the instrument of ratification was conducted between Armenia's Ambassador to India, Vahagn Afyan, and Abhishek Singh from the Indian Ministry of External Affairs. The ISA, headquartered in Gurugram, Haryana, focuses on promoting solar energy globally. **Dr. Ajay Mathur serves as its Director General.**

First three places have been kept empty followed by Denmark (fourth place).
global greenhouse gas (GHG) Emissions, Renewable Energy, Energy Use and Climate Policy

- India has been ranked 23rd globally in the Sustainable Trade Index 2024, as reported by the Hinrich Foundation and IMD. The index evaluates countries based on three pillars: economic growth, societal advancement, and environmental resilience. New Zealand topped the index with a perfect score of 100, followed by the United Kingdom, Australia, Singapore, and Japan.
- Bihar has been chosen to host the Khelo India Youth Games and Khelo India Para Games in April 2025, highlighting the state's commitment to sports development. This marks the first time Bihar will host these prestigious multi-sport events, featuring young and para-athletes from across the country
- The World Bank's 'Jobs at Your Doorstep' report concentrates on six states, proposing a comprehensive framework for the entire country. Unveiled by Education Minister Dharmendra Pradhan and Labour Minister Mansukh Mandaviya, the report prioritizes skilling, redefining jobs and addresses technology-driven shifts in employment
- AroTrack' is a water-pollutant detecting device developed by scientists at IIT Bombay. It uses bacteria-derived proteins to detect harmful aromatic pollutants like phenol, benzene, and xylenols in water. A key feature of AroTrack is its ability to identify pollutants through a chemical reaction that causes a visible colour change.
- The haka protest was staged in New Zealand by Maori lawmakers in response to the Treaty Principles Bill, which proposes a reinterpretation of the 1840 Treaty of Waitangi. The protest, involving the traditional Maori dance, was a powerful symbol of the community's opposition to the bill, as it could dilute the specific rights granted to the Maori people. The haka, historically used in battle, is now a strong cultural expression used to assert unity and strength, particularly in protests related to Maori rights and protections.



- The 'One Day One Genome' initiative was launched in New Delhi on the 1st foundation day of the Biotechnology Research and Innovation Council (BRIC). This initiative aims to showcase India's microbial diversity by releasing fully annotated bacterial genomes, along with summaries, infographics, and genome data
- The VISION Portal (Viksit Bharat Initiative for Student Innovation and Outreach Network), inaugurated by Dr. Jitendra Singh, aims to empower underprivileged youth through education, skill development, and sustainable livelihoods
- India's first AI laboratory in space- TM2Space, a Hyderabad-based space technology company, is set to launch MOI-TD (My Orbital Infrastructure – Technology Demonstrator)
- E-Khata by the Bruhat Bengaluru Mahanagara Palike (BBMP) is an online system that provides property owners in Bengaluru with a digital record of their property tax details.
- The Karnataka Space Technology Policy 2024–29 is an ambitious initiative by the Karnataka government to position the state as a leading hub in the global space industry. Unveiled in November 2024, the policy outlines strategic goals and missions to enhance the state's role in both national and international space sectors.
- National Tiger Conservation Authority (NTCA) recommended notifying Nugu Wildlife Sanctuary as a core and critical area of Bandipur Tiger Reserve
 - It is built across the Nugu River, a tributary of the Cauvery. In 1974, Nugu was declared a Wildlife Sanctuary, and later, in year 2003-2004, the area of Nugu Wildlife Sanctuary was added to the Nilgiri Biosphere Reserve.
- Karnataka Office of Labour Commissioner has invited stakeholders to submit their, suggestions/ feedback, on the proposal of granting six days of annual paid menstrual leave to women workers across various industries
- The Bengaluru traffic police have introduced ASTraM (Actionable Intelligence for Sustainable Traffic Management) to enhance traffic management

Bihar and Kerala are the only Indian states that have introduced menstrual leave
Some companies in India have introduced menstrual leave policies, including Zomato, which announced a 10-day paid period leave per year in 2020. Other companies, such as Swiggy and Byjus, have also followed suit

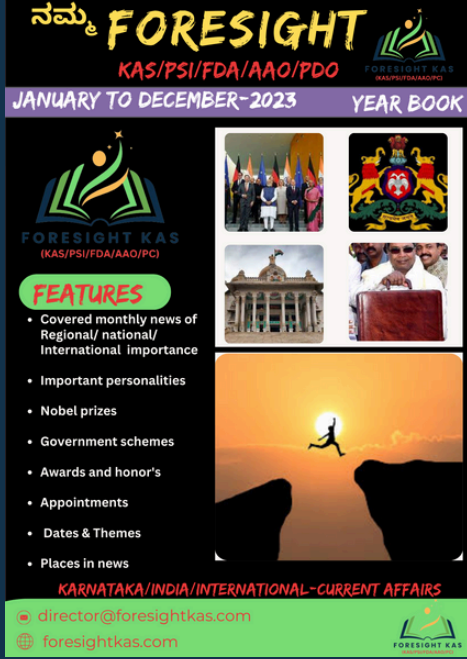
